

Annual review of modern slavery risk in operations - 2026

Process of evaluation and risk assessment

A mapping exercise is completed annually on operations and Tier 1 supplier in the sectors: Construction, Cleaning, Catering, Security, Maintenance.

These sectors are more associated with modern slavery risk than others and have a direct impact on Taylor Wessing's operations.

Scope: This includes suppliers associated with Taylor Wessing's operations in their London office only (5 New Street Square, London).

A 'QHSE-51 Supplier modern slavery risk assessment' is completed for each applicable supplier to identify any risks. The Property and Workplace Team assess each supplier. Evidence of best practice is collected including policy statements. Additionally, searches for negative media are completed and discussions with employees are conducted.

The results are reviewed by the Property and Workplace Team who provide a score. A summary is produced and shared.

Results of evaluation

No evidence of modern slavery was identified on assessment. All companies assessed had clear policies in place. All staff spoken with appeared well with no indication of modern slavery practices. No construction contractor at present.
