<b>Content harmful to children</b> (applies to services likely to be accessed by children)	Primary priority content harmful to children	Pornographic content and content that encourages, promotes or provides instructions for suicide, self-harm, or eating disorders/behaviours.	Content the impact of which flows from its potential financial impact, safety/quality of goods featured in the content, or the way in which a service featured in the content may be performed.
	Priority content harmful to children	Bullying content, content that is abusive or incites hatred on grounds of race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, disability or gender reassignment, that encourages/promotes/instructs on serious violence against a person or a challenge/stunt likely to result in serious injury, that depicts serious violence or (in graphic detail) serious injury against a person/animal/fictional creature, or that encourages self-administration of physically harmful substances.	
	Non-designated content harmful to children	Content not mentioned above which presents a material risk of significant harm to an appreciable number of children in the UK.	
<b>Content relevant to adult user empowerment duties (Adult User Content)</b> (applies to Category 1 services only)	Content which encourages, promotes or provides instructions for suicide, self-harm or eating disorders/behaviours, or is abusive or incites hatred on grounds of race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, disability or gender reassignment.
